NOTIFICATION

2nd Round of State Medical P.G. Seats Allotment-2018 (Offline)

It is for the information to all concerned registered candidates seeking admission to various PG Medical (Degree/Diploma) Course that the 2nd Round of Allotment Procedure for State Medical (P.G.) Seats will be held Offline as scheduled below:

- The candidates who have already been registered for State PG Admissions 2018, but have not filled choices in round 1st are also eligible for counseling.
- Candidates who have filled Part -1 of Registration and Deposited registration fee but did not fill Part -2 are also eligible for 2nd round of Counseling.
- Those candidates who have resigned by 19/04/2018 (5.00 PM) after reporting/joined in any Medical College of India through All India counseling of NEET 2018 and are willing to seek allotment through this 2nd round of state counselling **will have to bring their original documents at the time of counselling.**
- Those candidates who have already taken admission in Govt./Private Medical College of Rajasthan through this Counseling Board 2018 and have submitted their original documents in the concerned college will have to produce the fee receipt (original) of the previously allotted and joined college and will have to deposit required Bond and complete other formalities at the time of counseling.
- Candidates who have not got admission in any college are required to submit their **original documents & required Bonds** at the time of counseling.

The allotment of the subject and college shall be made strictly on the basis of merit cum preference and in accordance with the rules as laid down by M.C.I./Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/Hon'ble High Court, Rajasthan/Government of Rajasthan and Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur and Rules/Regulation of Private University as applicable.

Note: The candidates must read the following instruction/information carefully:

1. The candidates are advised to read the instructions etc. given on the website.
2. Non registered candidates, candidates who did not join on their previously allotted seats and candidates who resigned earlier from allotted seats will not be considered for allotment in the process of the counseling of the 2nd round.
3. Any candidate opting the subject not recognized by the MCI, New Delhi will not be allowed to claim for any change on this ground, except during subsequent round of allotment, if any, depending upon his/her merit and as per preference only. The candidates are required to visit website of Medical Council of India, regarding Permission/Recognition/Current Status of Post graduate seats in Govt./Private Medical Colleges of Rajasthan. The admission board will not be responsible for the consequences, if any.
4. No individual information shall be sent to the candidates for the allotment.
5. A candidate who is pursuing studies at present must produce the accepted resignation from the institution alongwith original documents, at the time of counseling. Failure to do so will result in disqualification for admission.
6. The candidates opting for a PG seat in Govt. Medical college, will have to submit a surety bond of Rs. 5.00 Lac (Rupees Five Lacs) in favour of Principal of the allotted college at the time of counseling. At the time of final joining, the candidate will have to submit Bank Guarantee for the amount of Rs. 1.5 Lacs and Bond for Rs. 3.5 Lacs. The earlier bond of Rs.5 Lacs submitted in the concerned college will be returned to the candidates.
7. The candidates opting for any PG seat in Private Medical College of Rajasthan, will have to submit a Surety Bond in favour of Principal of the admitting college at the time of counseling, amounting to One Year Fee for the allotted subject in that Private Medical College and will have to complete all other formalities, as notified on respective college website by 03.05.2018 by 5.00 PM.
8. As per state government directions the candidates who are not in service under Govt. of Rajasthan but so selected under both All India and State Quota for various PG Degree/Diploma courses for the academic session 2018-19 in Government Medical Colleges, will have to fill a bond of commitment to serve the State Government of Rajasthan for a period of Five (05) years. If any candidate fails to do so, he/she will have to pay a sum of Rs. 25 Lac (Rupees Twenty-five Lac) for Degree course and Rs. 5 Lac (Rupees Five Lacs) for Diploma course to the state government.
9. **All Other formalities will have to completed by the student at concerned college by 03 May, 2018 by 5.00 PM**
10. If any candidate has already taken his/her admission in colleges that do not come under the purview of this admission board, he/she is required to attend the counseling along with original documents, otherwise his/her candidature will not be considered.
11. **Candidates opting for NRI seat in Private Medical colleges, will have to bring the NRI Sponsorship Letter, Rajasthan State Status (for preference) at the time of Counseling along with original documents and complete all other formalities in all respects.**
12. **All the allotment procedures will be provisional and will be subject to the Final Decisions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/ Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan in various related matters.**
13. In case of any dispute, the area of jurisdiction will be Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court, only.
